### **Brief Description of Ph.D. Research**

Major changes that took place in Hirakud Command Area (HCA) of Mahanadi River Basin Odisha, during the post-construction period are completely different from what was originally envisaged at the time of the project commissioning. This has big impact on productivity, drainage management, salinity, climate change and sustainability, rural and urban infrastructure. The state sponsored water user associations (WUA) are performing very badly as that of traditional irrigation institutions. The main purpose of the thesis is to critically examine Odisha's water management challenges in an overall context of changing frontiers of water sector in India. *The thesis documented the key water management challenges in overall perspectives in which socio-economic, technical, institutional and environmental factors are inter-related.* The sustainability, stability and food-security call for an urgent need for more participatory and pragmatic water management techniques. The thesis can contribute to advancing processes of participatory water governance and management (with more effective multi-stakeholder participation), which can lead more efficient and equitable water distribution, and sustainable development.

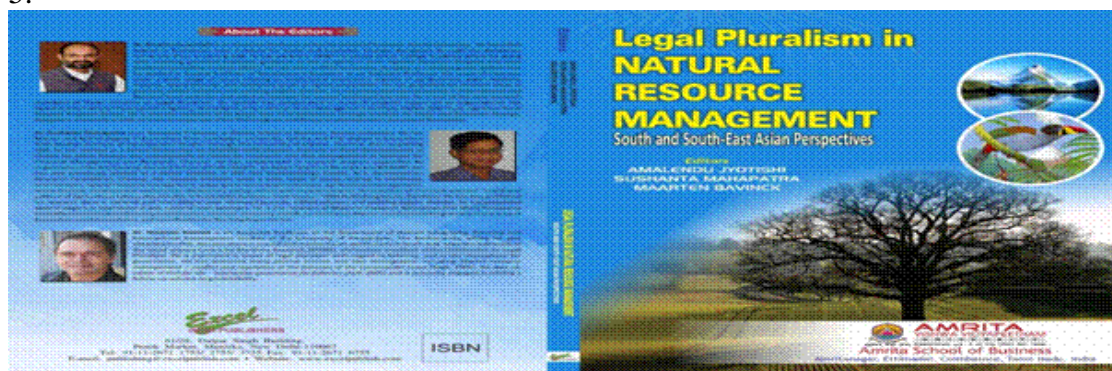
